



Compare Iron-A-Way to the Competition

- **Superior Cabinet Construction:** Iron-A-Way uses hardwood, Big Box retailers sell product using a less durable melamine covered particle board.
- **Cabinet Depth** is much deeper to allow storage of most irons on the market. Big Box retailers product typically will only allow a narrower/smaller iron.
- **Ironing Board:** Iron-A-Way uses steel ventilated to allow better rigidity and ventilation which benefits longer life and better performance especially when using a steam iron. Many competitors use a melamine unvented board with little rigidity and no ventilation for steam irons.
- **Swivel Option:** Iron-A-Way uses superior hardware integrated into the storage hardware giving up nothing in overall rigidity but allows for maneuverability of the board while ironing. Most of the competitors use a less expensive simple nut and bolt through the center of the board which is prone to stressing the board's integrity thus limiting the life of the ironing station.
- **Electrical Models:** All Iron-A-Way electric models are UL approved which are built in to the unit for assurance of safety. They have a timer and shut-off feature in the case of unattended use. Big Box units offer an add-on kit which has to be installed on the job which is not UL rated.
